

As a parent/guardian, we understand you have the right to:




- be assured that your child is safeguarded during their time with us.
- know how to access Mad About Swimming policies, rules and procedures.
- know who the Mad About Swimming Welfare Officer is and how to contact them
- know that any concerns about your child's welfare will be listened to and responded to.
- know what qualifications and training those with responsibility for your child have.
- keep informed of problems or concerns relating to your child, where appropriate.
- know the procedure should your child be involved in an accident or become injured.
- provide your consent or otherwise for photography.
- make a complaint to the Swim School Director or Welfare Officer (as appropriate).

As a parent/guardian of a child or young person, we kindly request that you:

- complete all consent, contact and medical forms and update us straight away with any changes.
- contact us if you wish to talk to us about any concerns regarding your child. We will arrange a mutually convenient time so you can talk to our Swimming School Director.
- do not enter poolside during lessons, unless in an emergency situation or at the discretion of the teacher or Swim School Director.



- remove footwear before entering the changing rooms or use plastic shoe protectors.
- respect and celebrate difference in our club and not discriminate against anyone else on the grounds of gender, race, sexual orientation, faith or ability.
- do not use electronic devices on poolside unless directed to do so in an emergency situation by a teacher or lifeguard.
- support Mad About Swimming Teachers to address your child's behaviour if it is considered detrimental to the safety, enjoyment and progress of other swimmers.



- toilet facilities, etc, are the responsibility of the parent/carer.
- Allocation of a place is for the whole term. This can only be changed during the term if the teacher is satisfied that the child needs to be in a different class.
- Mad about Swimming reserve the right to end a child's allocated swimming place, if it is considered that a child's needs cannot be met or if a child or teacher's safety is at risk.
- REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AT THE DISCRETION OF MAD ABOUT **SWIMMING**
